THE PREPARATION:

for plays, scenes, monologues, ANYTHING!!!

WHERE AM I?

Time: year, hour, night, day, etc. Place: city, country, room, outdoors

WHAT JUST HAPPENED

The given or imagined circumstances that happened before the first beat.

WHAT DO I WANT?

My overall objective, need, goal in the scene

WHAT'S IN MY WAY?

The obstacle

WHAT DO I DO TO GET WHAT I WANT?

These are the actions of the scene that lead me to get what I want (ie. to fight, to demand, to interrogate, to charm, to plead)

Not only do you need to answer all these questions, now you must do a SHERLOCK HOLMES on the play or scene, other characters and find SPECIFIC substitutions/transferences for who you are dealing with or speak of in the scene. You can never be TOO SPECIFIC!!
